





Left: The Great God Pan . . . down in the reeds by the river.

Left: Then Pygmalion covered his eyes.





Right: She checked her hounds, and stood beside Endymion.




Left: Swiftly he turned and found his wife behind him.

Left: She stopped and picked up the treasure.


Right: Marpessa sat alone by the fountain.
